

WEEKLY TREND REPORT

Week Ending 17th March 2013

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1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

There were 4 Critical incidents and 23 Major incidents over the last week. The critical incident involved the Perimeter breach of a number of clients on the [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] March. Two of those perimeter breaches were in relation to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] breached his bail conditions and as a result on the second occasion was remanded in Police custody. There were also 12 Self harm incidents, 4 attempted suicides by hanging, 3 assaults, 1 client departure [REDACTED] and 2 Use of Force Incidents. There have been no further incidents involving clients stitching their lips during the week. Currently there are 2 clients with their lips stitched.

There was a dramatic increase in the number of self harm incidents during the week. The month of February is accountable for 35% of self harm incidents since the centre opened in September 2012. Of the 23 major incidents which occurred during the week [REDACTED] was accountable for 10 of them. These incidents coincide with [REDACTED].

There were 6 recorded assaults for the month of February, which is 37% of the total amount since the centre opened. These incidents are limited to a small population and not spread over the whole community. In conjunction with this is the rise of assault complaints against staff members. Use of Force incidents have also risen over the last week and this is also contributed towards the assaults and self harm incidents.

The protest activity is continuing daily with approximately 30 – 40 persons attending. The number of attendees at the daily protest is steadily declining. Currently on VS are 10 persons, which is a decrease of 33% since last week. Of this there are 9 [REDACTED] and 1 [REDACTED] nationals participating in the VS.

There has been no reported incident against property this week.

Risk profiles for Vulnerable and anti-social clients are all showing as Iranians. This again can be related to the participation of these clients in the daily protest activities.

Incidents by nationality continue to show [REDACTED]

High risk clients currently consist of 7 [REDACTED] clients and 1 [REDACTED] client who require a two man escort when attending medical (IHMS).
